

Activities & Challenges

Activities and Challenges are graded based on the packet that is handed in by the group. Typically in that packet, there is :

- a sheet for students to get the teacher's signature after he witnesses the program being run,
- written / printed out programs for each program successfully run (each sheet should have the student programmer's name, group color, and the name/number of the program that it is)

Although students do their work in a group, they are responsible for their own work. When grading, the teacher will look to make sure the overall amount of work was divided up evenly and each student did the appropriate number of programs. (*Ex: In a group of 3 if there are 12 programs to figure out, the teacher will make sure that each individual student has 4 signatures and has written or printed out 4 programs.*) If one student decided to do more or less work, it does not affect the group as a whole with the exception of if they do too much of the work and do not leave any programs for the rest of the group to work on. The group can elect to work collectively on programs but only one student can take credit for each program.
